Dear Eighth Grade Parent(s) and Students:

As the school year rapidly draws to a close, we would like to share with you information regarding the last weeks of school. Please keep this letter available for reference.

Saturday, May 6th—Confirmation Practice—10:30 A.M. in the church with sponsors. Please arrive at **10:15 A.M.** with sponsors.

Sunday, May 7th—Confirmation—4:30 P.M. Meet in the Social Level at 3:00 P.M. if you are having an individual picture taken, 3:30 P.M. for the group picture which will be at 3:45 P.M.

Friday, May 12th--8th Grade Dinner and Dance—in the Social Level—6:30 P.M. Social, 7:00 P.M. Dinner with Dance to follow.

Thursday, May 18th--8th Grade Field Trip. We will walk to the Papio Bowl in the morning and ride the bus to FunPlex in the afternoon. Pizza will be provided for lunch at FunPlex. The attire for this day will be 8th grade spirit shirts and jeans, khaki or denim shorts (following the guidelines below), or capris. **Please note for bowling, students will need socks.**

Friday, May 19th--Field Day. Students will need to bring a cold sack lunch with a drink on field day. Please do not send any foods that require microwaving. Regarding proper dress for this day:

- All students must wear tennis shoes and socks.
- Shorts are allowed on Field Day. They must be of modest length- no more than 4 inches above the knee. Most styles of running shorts will not fit this guideline. Longer length athletic shorts (other than biking shorts) fitting this guideline are welcome. Bermuda shorts are also an option for girls.
- Please send your child to school with uniform bottoms in his/her backpack on Field Day. If your child's shorts are deemed inappropriate for our Catholic school setting, s/he will be asked to change into the school uniform for the day.
- We ask that boys not wear carpenter-style shorts with loops on this day for safety reasons.

Monday, May 22—All School Mass at 8:15 A.M. Scholarships and awards will be presented after this All School Mass. No scholarships or honors will be presented at the Graduation Mass.

Immediately following Mass, we will practice for graduation. After practice, students will be dismissed from the front of church. Students will be ready for pick up at 10:45.

This is a uniform day. This will be the last day of school for 8th graders.

Tuesday, May 23—Graduation! Students gather in the Social Level by 6:15 P.M. We will gather the class on the risers so that parents can take pictures at 6:30 P.M. Please be on time as we cannot wait for late arrivals. Even though students will be wearing robes for the graduation ceremony, we ask that you please help your student choose modest attire for graduation. Boys should wear a collared shirt with a tie. Students need to wear dress shoes. Dressy sandals for girls are fine. Mass begins at 7:00 P.M.

We always look forward to this last busy part of the school year and wish you all the best of luck in your future endeavors. We will continue to keep all of you in our prayers. Thank you so much for your continued support.
