The "community closet" is used for children and teens to borrow equipment until no longer needed or until they outgrow them, then be passed along to others in need. It also serves as a way for community adults to mentor them in their sports efforts, so as to be sure they are headed in the right direction. In the past, these coaches have seen children show up to soccer tryouts and tournaments with cardboard taped to their shins with duct tape, just to be able to play.

You can help by donating used youth sporting items such as: shin guards, soccer cleats, football cleats, wrestling shoes, baseball cleats or baseball gloves.

(ANY sports equipment will be accepted, these are just the high need items.)
